Through reviewing relevant literature, this thesis drives a journey of knowledge from probing the evolution of Servitization, through reviewing its competitive dynamics, toward identifying the enabling factors of its implementation. Management decisions of the host company (i.e. Hellenic Aerospace Industry) are evaluated with respect to the identified enablers. The aligned directions between these enablers and company’s practices verify the theory in the context of aerospace industry, whereas the skewed directions reflect the difficulty in practice. This thesis provides a comprehensive understanding of the Servitization concept, which can be used by the host company to servitize its offerings to differentiate from its global competitors.

The performance of a Genetic Algorithm is studied in this dissertation. This Algorithm is designed to find the best solution of the Team Orienteering Problem, where multiple vehicles begin from different starting points and conclude their routes at the same depot. The operational parameters are examined for their significance through an integrated design of experiments. More specifically, two prototype problems of bibliography are used to implement the experiments and results are analyzed through Analysis of Variance (ANOVA). The analysis determines which parameters are statistically important for achieving good scores, and which parameters are statistically important for achieving small run times.
